

Five open positions – student assistants in the Climart project

Three positions with a total of 112.5 hours (20.06.-07.07.17)

Two positions with a total of 24 hours (20.-22.06.17)



Within the **CLIMart Project** we seek three student assistants from Tuesday the 20th of June to Friday the 7th of July. The student assistants will guide the visitors of an exciting artwork at Festningen (see www.climart.info for more information) and take part in data collections around the artwork. The artwork is part of the Starmus – in the City Alternative Festival.

The tasks of the students will include **informing the visitors** about the artwork they are about to experience, as well as **recruiting visitors** of the artwork and the Starmus festival to participate in a questionnaire survey. The tasks can be switched between the three volunteers from day to day, to enable everyone to work in each part of the project. All three assistants will be on site from Tuesday until Friday of the three weeks. The work will be **full time (37.5 hours per week) for the period of the exhibition**. Working hours will be during opening hours of the artwork (Tuesday to Thursday from 11:30-20:30 o'clock, Friday from 11:30-22:30).

The other two student assistants will assist data collections in the city, during the Martnan festival (<http://martnan.no/>). The focus here is on the questionnaire survey and recruiting participants for it, for 8 hours per day from the 20th to the 22th of June.

The students need to be fluent in Norwegian and English. They will be instructed by the PhD candidates.

Payment according to Student Assistant regulations.

Qualifications needed:

- Being enrolled as student at NTNU
- Enjoy being around people - no problem with approaching strangers
- Good skills in speaking Norwegian and English
