


O Increasing Complexity!

Two forms of uses

O Common-sense, daily usage, somethings that is messy, difficult to comprehend, obscure

Systems thinking –
 sciences of complexity;
 focus on non-linearity



Non-linear causation

- O Be concrete
- O Be innovative
- O Be flexible
- O Be specific



Aspects of being concrete



- Levels of complexity
 - The simple
 - The complicated
 - The complex
- Developing and using models

Aspects of being innovative

- Synthesis as well as analysis
- Towards a contingency theory of evaluating the complex
- O Evaluation design



Aspects of being flexible



- Multiple questions/issues, gradual focus
- Theories of change (note the plural form)
- Towards the assessment of worth and merit
- Multiple levels and perspectives

Aspects of being specific

- Composition of evaluation teams
 - C Legitimacy
 - Knowledge of the evaluand
 - Methodologies, method, data collection and analysis
 - Interaction with stakeholder groups
