Dear members of NRSGH,

We invite PhD candidates affiliated with the Norwegian Research School in Global Health to submit up to three photos that exemplify "life of a PhD student in global health" or capture a key global health challenge, solution or research question central to the PhD research undertaken by the individual PhD candidate.

The photos should be submitted as JPG files. Each JPG file should be between 2-3 MB in size to ensure high enough resolution for printing. We will emphasize that professional equipment is not necessary, but photos taken by smartphones without additional equipment is more than good enough. For each submitted image, a brief text (up to 100 words) should be included to capture the context represented by the photo. A panel will select three photos to be featured on the home page of the NRSGH to represent some of the important areas of research covered by research school. The three best photos will be awarded with respectively 1000, 2000 and 3000 NOK.

The PhD candidates will maintain ownership of their photos, but NRSGH will reserves the right to use submitted photographs in promotional material or general communication, but the photographer will be credited the work.

In cases where people feature on the photo, the photographer will need to obtain verbal consent from the persons they wish to photograph and ensure they are comfortable with it and treated with dignity. Pictures of children will need verbal consent of their parents or guardians. The photographer need to be particularly mindful when taking pictures of the vulnerability and privacy of people who are receiving health care will need to respected their privacy and follow the rules of their health care facility. NRSGH always encourage the photographer to be mindful of whether or not the photo is representing the person or community accurately.
