CONFERENCE REPORT

I attended the 16th International Conference on Informatics, Management, and Technology in Healthcare (ICIMTH 2018) which took place in Hotel Divani Palace Acropolis, Athens, Greece on 6th – 8th July 2018. The theme of the conference was Data, Informatics, and Technology: An Inspiration for Improved Healthcare where knowledge on research findings and innovations was disseminated through 5 keynotes, 80 full papers and almost 20 posters, 1 tutorial, 2 workshops, and 2 panels.

The knowledge shared was an eye opener on the how ICTs are being used to address the current challenges in healthcare especially in developed countries. What was of importance to note is how ICTs are being used to empower the patients especially the aged and those with chronic conditions to take control over their life despite their health condition.
