


## "Cybersecurity training does not work!"

Human vulnerabilities are considered one of the biggest weaknesses in cybersecurity and employees are increasingly being exploited by cybercriminals as a gateway to business assets [1,2,3].

Establishing security measures is an important part of how businesses manage security risks and threats. A widely used measure to counter this is security training and a large number of businesses regularly conduct such training for their employees [4,5]. Yet we see an increase in the number of attacks, despite employees undergoing security training and education in the workplace to increase security awareness [6]. This may indicate that cybersecurity training does not work as intended.

\*14 employees were interviewed, observed, took part in a survey, and an exercise as part of the study.

Employees at the same time reported possible violations/deviations of measures and training:

Take this about locking your computer, which is actually so obvious, but it's kind of like, you know the people around you so well, so maybe if you were just going to get a cup of coffee right next door, you wouldn't have locked your computer.
