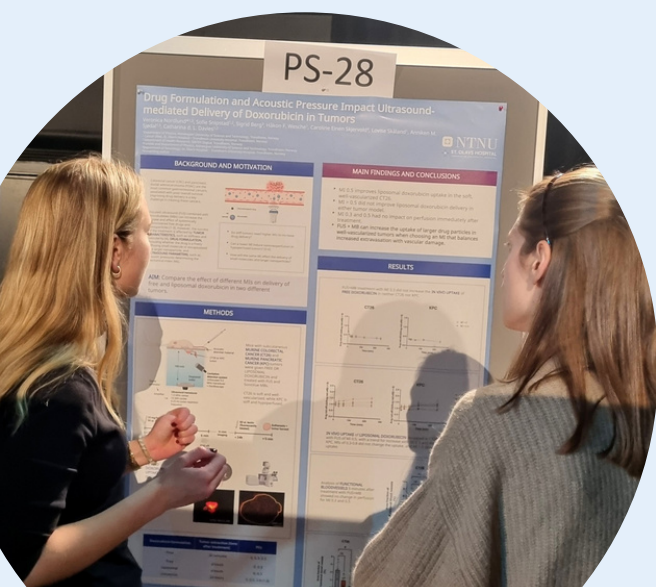
What to expect for 2026/2027

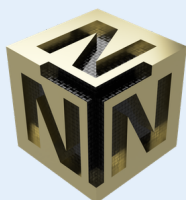
ECOSS2026

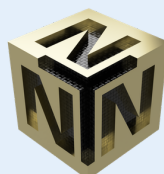
