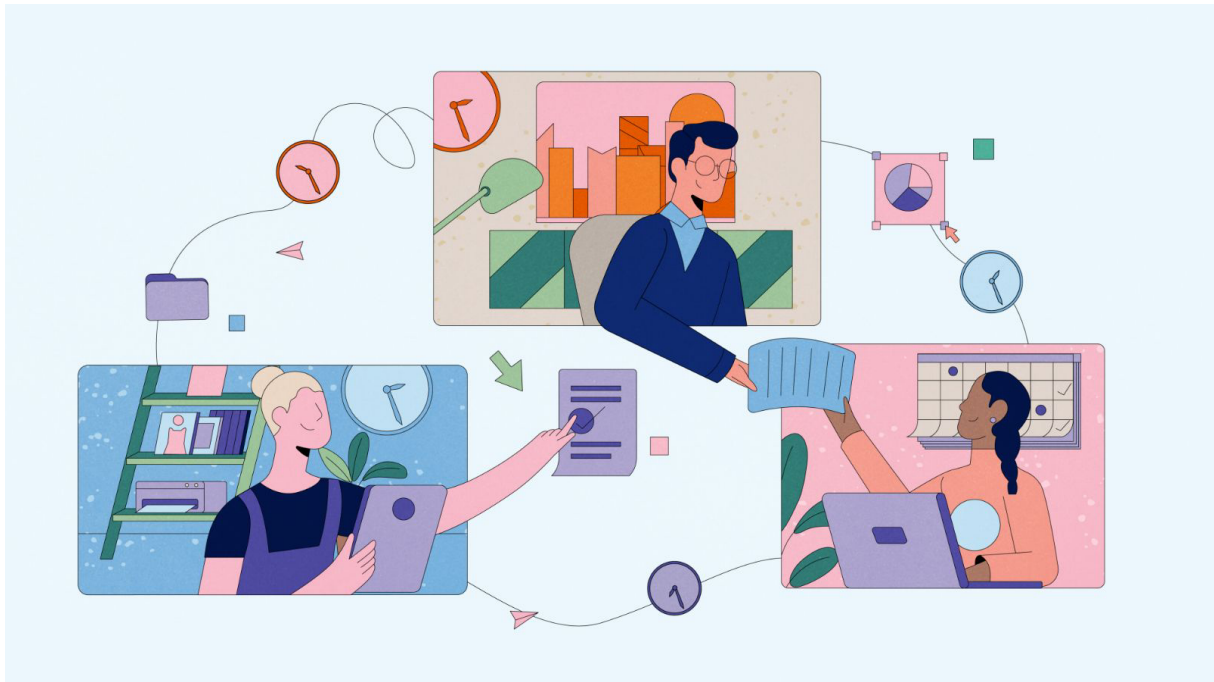


Interpretation workshop, GEN-PHD project

The duration of each interview was about one hour. I therefore have a 16-18 pages transcript for each interview: too much for a comprehensive collective qualitative analysis exercise. What we can do is focusing on discussing together the answers to one of the questions in the interview guide: **future academia: utopias and dystopias**.
