



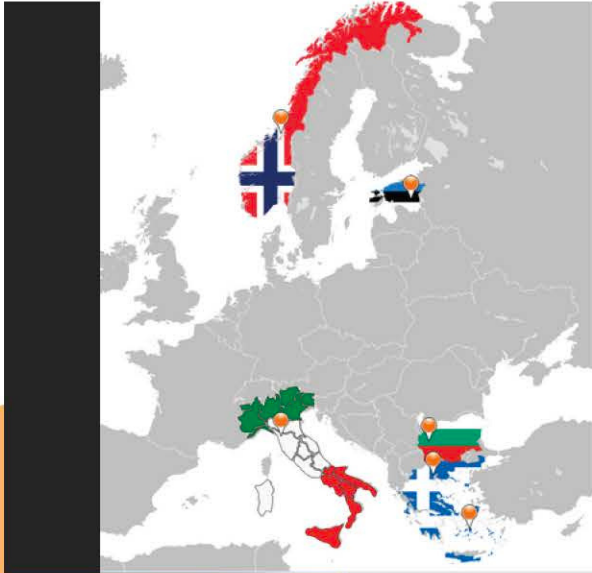

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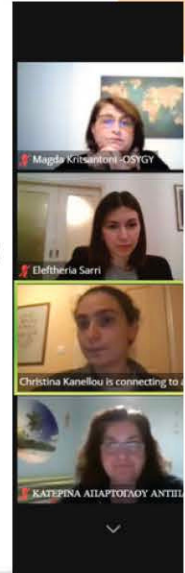

## OSYGY

As we enter the month of March, eCHOing is officially halfway through its 1st open-access publication. The final product is a collection of the best sustainable and modern practices of Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs), that will help revive Cultural Heritage Organizations (CHOs) through Open Innovation. Its task leader is the Federation of Women Associations, OSYGY, in Cyclades, Greece, which has completed the first tasks in a timely and efficient manner. However, it's important to say that all 6 partners have been key contributors to the project.

## WHAT'S BEEN DONE SO FAR

Things are becoming more and more enthusing, as our team is getting to know each other better, through monthly meetings, and producing its deliverables. Thus far, these include a desktop research on the collection of 30 European practices of HE engagement in the rebirth of cultural heritage, and a survey on HE readiness to reach out to CHOs and benefit from OI and such practices. In addition, OSYGY took the liberty of gathering its members and giving a presentation about PRI and its tasks, to better prepare each member on what's to come.

For eCHOing, the next few months look even more exciting, as we eagerly await the results of the survey on HE readiness in reaching out to CHOs and benefitting from Open Innovation practices. We cannot wait to share the results with you and the rest of our culture-enthusiastic community!



**eCHOING survey 1**

Conducted within the framework of the EU-funded project eCHOING "Recovery of cultural heritage through higher education-driven open innovation", this is a survey on the readiness of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in Europe to reach out to small and medium-sized Cultural Heritage Organizations (CHOs) and aims to establish an understanding on how collaborative projects can empower the recovery of the Cultural heritage sector in a post pandemic period.
