



Local Transportation Guide

How to travel in and around Trondheim

Welcome to Trondheim

Trondheim is situated in the middle of Norway and is therefore accessible with car, plane, bus, boat and train. In this short guide we hope to give some information on how to get around in Trondheim with respect to places relevant to Fusion 2026. This will include an introduction to the different transportation services offered by various agents, useful apps and webpages, and some general tips.

We hope that this guide will make your stay pleasant and help you move around in Trondheim

Arrival to Trondheim

When arriving in Trondheim, the key area lies in the area around Trondheim S. Trondheim S will unfortunately be closed during the conference, therefore some modifications to the first version for this travel guide are needed.

In the time of writing, it is only the train that is impacted by the temporary closure, whereas any travel by bus or on foot will not be impacted.

Thus, the only major impact will be for the conference participants that arrive by train from the airport.

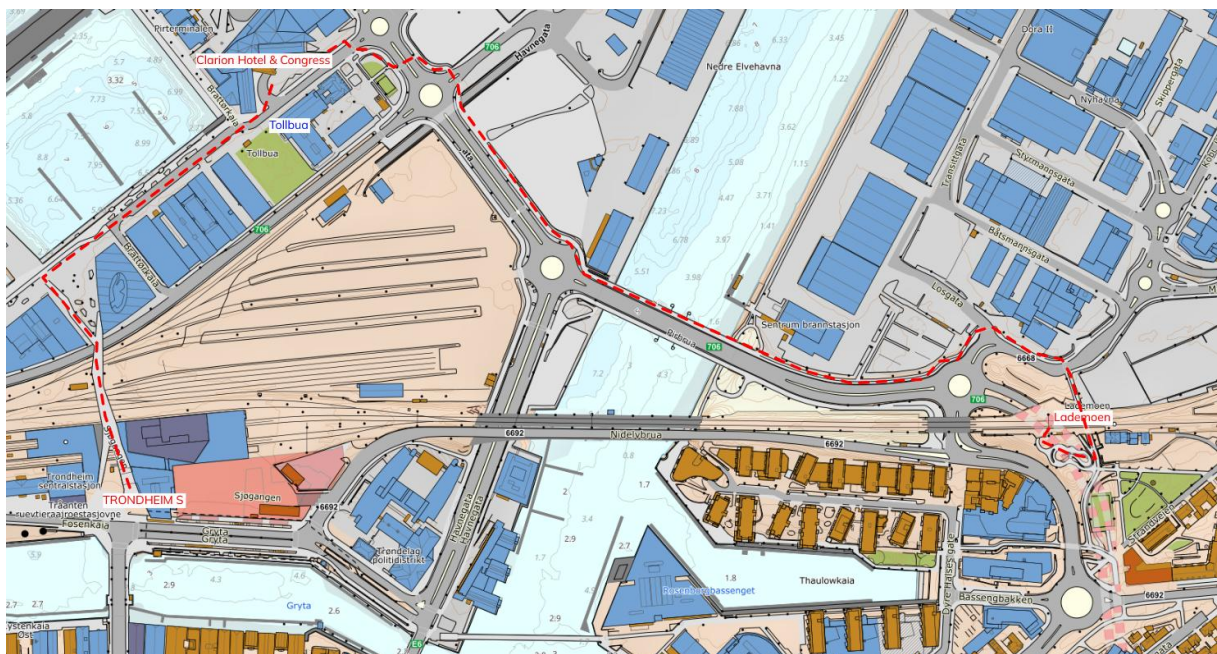


Figure 1. It shows the path from Lademoen and Trondheim S to the hotel

The main point of orientation should still be, despite the maintenance, Trondheim central station, [Trondheim S](#). Any Buss and boat and from outside of Trondheim will arrive here. This is also the case for train, as there will be substitute buses on the impacted section.

Trondheim S is situated north in Trondheim and is conveniently situated a short 500m walk away from the Conference hotel, [Clarion Hotel & Congress](#). For an interactive version, click [here](#).

When arriving by train, one can either walk a little less than 1 km from [Lademoen](#), or take the connecting bus to Trondheim S.

If you are arriving Trondheim by plane, there are three alternatives to get into the city. The Airport express bus, the Regional express buss, or the regional train. All alternatives with their scheduled arrival and departure times will show in the local transportation app, [AtB](#), or the national travel planner, [Entur](#). They will also show an interactive map from where the bus or train leaves.

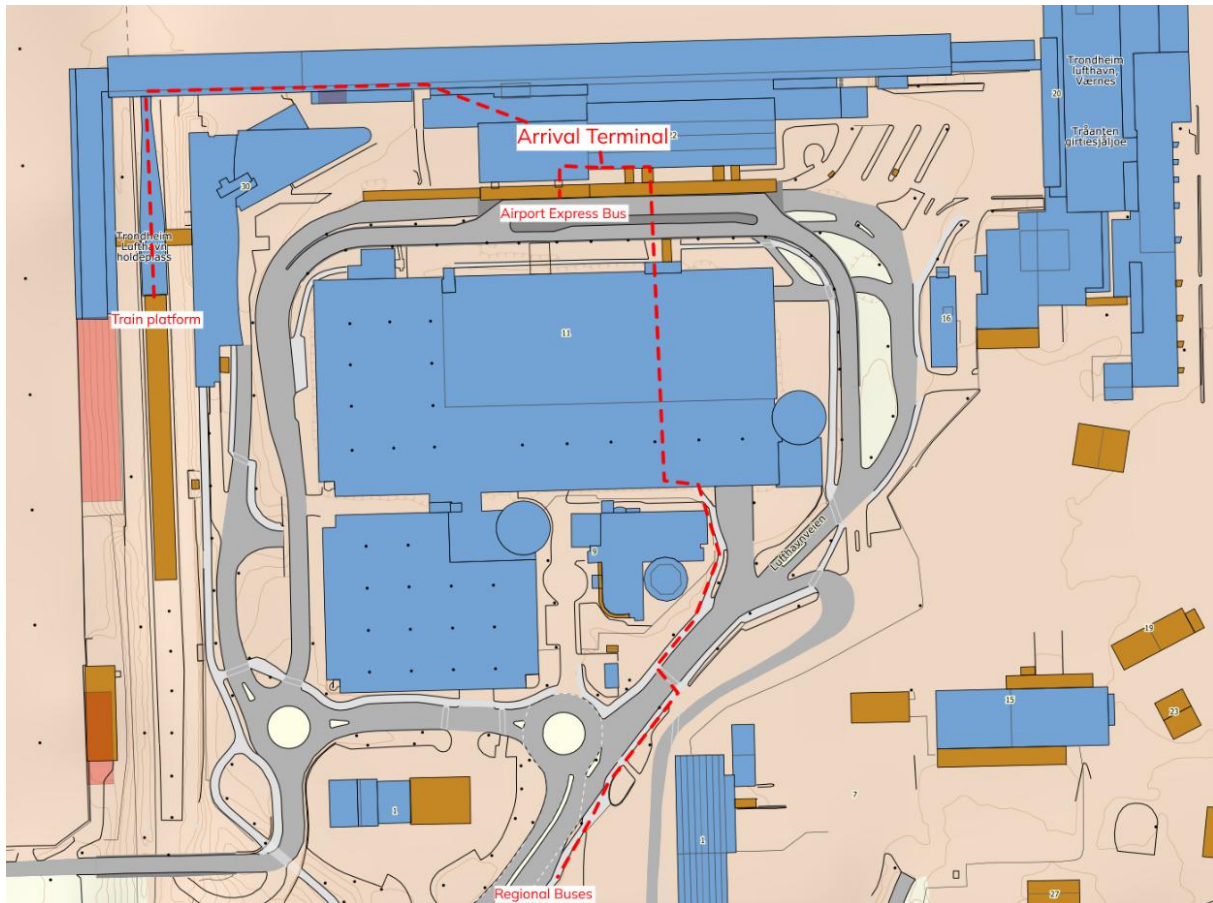
Except for the Airport express bus, tickets to both the train and normal buses can be bought through these two apps. It is the cheapest option with one ticket selling at 47 NOK at the time of writing.

The recommended travel option is by train, if possible, which leaves the airport three minutes over, once every hour. The regional express buses are less regular, but also a valid option. Note that the regional buses are situated a bit outside the airport, as shown on the map below.

The Airport Express bus, Værnesekspressen, is the most expensive option but has the benefit of driving all day and night, making it the most flexible option. Additionally, they are situated right outside the airport, making them very easily accessible. It does not stop at Trondheim S, but at [Olav Tryggvasons Gate](#) at the heart of the city, 400 m from Trondheim S. If you want to use the Airport Express Bus, it is recommended to purchase at least 24h ahead of travel to get the cheapest price possible at 225 NOK in the time of writing. They do have a discounted offer for students, but PhD

students are generally not considered a part of this discount. Purchasing tickets can be done at their webpage, Værnesekspresen.

Travel inside Trondheim

For travel inside Trondheim, the recommended mode of transport are local buses driven and operated by [AtB](#). As mentioned earlier, routes and planning can be done with both [Entur](#) and AtB, along with single ticket purchases. The AtB app also offers period tickets with the shortest one being for 24 hours, and is worth the price if you are going take three or more separate bus-rides within 24 hours. The single ticket option is the same one as that take you from the airport and to Trondheim S to 47 NOK.

We make the reader aware that the buses operate on a trust-based principle where it is assumed that you have purchased a ticket before entering the bus. Ticket control occurs at random intervals, and a hefty fine is issued upon failing to produce a valid ticket.

The travel inside Trondheim will in most cases consist of transportation between the following destinations in Trondheim and their recommended bus-stop that combines frequency and options. More options are available through the route planner feature in the respective apps.

- [Clarion Hotel & Congress](#) – Conference Hotel and main area.
Recommended bus stop(s): Trondheim S/Brattøra
- [Tollbua](#) – Restaurant right next to Clarion Hotel & Congress.
- [NTNU Kalvskinnet](#) – NTNU facility.
Recommended bus stop(s): Kongens Gate
- [Erkebispegården](#) – Meeting point near Nidarosdomen.
Recommended bus stop(s): Nidarosdomen
- [Nyhavna](#) – Research center near the harbour
Recommended bus stop(s): Losgate, Dora

Travel between Clarion Hotel & Congress and Kongens Gate/Nidarosdomen

Travelling from Clarion Hotel & Congress to either Kongens Gate or Nidarosdomen is recommended from Trondheim S. Other bus stops exist but have less frequency and options. The route is perhaps the most travelled in Trondheim with many buses passing through both Kongens Gate and Nidarosdomen right after one another.

The most frequent buses that drive this route are: 2, 10, 20, 25, 70.

Direction of travel to Nidarosdomen/Kongens Gate: South.

Direction of travel to Trondheim S: North.

Travel between Clarion Hotel & Congress and Nyhavna

Travel between the Clarion Hotel & Congress and Nyhavn can be done either by [foot](#) or by bus. If the bus is desired, then the recommended bus stop from the Hotel is [Brattøra](#), situated south east from the hotel. From there, bus number 20 leaves directly to Nyhavna, where the recommended bus stop to get off is [Losgata](#).

When travelling from Nyhavna, use the bus-stop [Dora](#), and bus 20 back to Brattøra.

Direction of travel to Nyhavna: East.

Direction of travel to Brattøra: West.

Travel between Nyhavna and Kongens Gate or Nidarosdomen

In the situation of travelling between Nyhavna and Kongens Gate / Nidarosdomen, Bus number 2 can also be used. It travels at a higher frequency and also stops at Trondheim S.

Direction of travel to Nyhavna: North-East.

Direction of travel to Nidarosdomen: South-West.
