

Doctoral students working on their theses in the field of **Operations Research applied to Health Services** are invited to submit a research proposal paper for the doctoral colloquium (DC) hosted within the ORAHS 2025 conference in Trondheim. The submissions can be current working papers as well as dissertation theses outlines. Submissions do not need to adhere to any formatting guidelines, but students should indicate if it is a working paper or a thesis outline. We ask students to try and limit the length of their submission to 10 pages, excluding references.

Please send the submission as a pdf to melanie.reuter-oppermann@dgre.org. The size of the file must not exceed 5MB.

The deadline for submission: Friday 11th April 2025 (anywhere on Earth).

Accepted submissions will be presented by students during the colloquium and discussed with a plenum of distinguished international researchers in the field. In addition, students will have one-on-one discussions with the international experts and profit from inspiring plenaries as well as insights into real-world planning problems from healthcare practitioners. The colloquium will be held prior to the main conference on Saturday 5th and Sunday 6th July 2025.

Registration to the DC will be possible only together with the conference registration.

Students presenting their research during the colloquium may also wish to present their research as a regular talk or poster during the main conference. Then, an additional submission to the regular conference is required (<u>submission</u>). Registration fees are stated on the website (<u>Registration - NTNU</u>).
