Horizon Europe Work Programmes for 2025-2026 have been published

The final work programmes for Horizon Europe are now available. If you are applying to a call in Pillar II of Horizon Europe this year, please make sure you are <u>referring to the final version of the topic description</u>.

The calls and topics are now also visible and available to read within the EU portal.

Calls Open: 22 May

Single-Stage Deadline: 16 Sept. 2025

Two-Stage Deadlines: 16 Sept. 2025 / 16 April 2026

Incentive funding for EU projects from Helse-Midt Norge

PROJECT ESTABLISHMENT FUNDING

Helse-Midt Norge offers up to 250 000 NOK in project establishment funding for applications to Horizon Europe where local PES support is insufficient or unapplicable.

SUPPORT FUNDS FOR AWARDED HEU PROJECTS

Additionally, support for running costs related to awarded Horizon Europe projects is available up to 10% of the award amount (max 1 million NOK).

Useful Details:

Applications can be in English or Norwegian.

If you apply for support for awarded projects, you can submit the description of action from part B of your application as the project description.

Please note that collaboration with a health organization within Helse Midt-Norge is a prerequisite for these funds.

NB: HMN have received very few applications in both these categories and if we want such funds to continue to be available, we need to use of them. Thus, we encourage everyone applying to a HEU call (even if you are now past the 6-month cut-off before the application deadline) and those who have an awarded project to apply. This includes ERC, Health cluster (or other cluster), Pathfinder, Marie Curie actions etc.

Research and Innovation to Strengthen the Sustainability of Municipal Health and Care Services

This call funds innovation processes that are based on the needs of patients, citizens or the public health services, and that can contribute to sustainability in the health and care services and to value creation in Norwegian business and industry.

NB: The project owner must either be a company (collaborating with at least one partner in the public health and care sector) or a public enterprise (collaborating with at lease one enterprise that is registered in the Norwegian Register of Business Enterprises and that has economic activity in Norway. Research institutions may participate as R&D providers

The English version of the planned call is not yet available.

Collaborative project to prevent and combat violence in close relationships (planned)

Call Opens: 01 October 2025 Deadline: 12 November 2025

This project that requires collaboration between research groups and actors outside of the research sector.
