Remember that EOI deadlines are attached to access to project establishment funding (PES) so in submitting an EOI, you maybe be able to get some funding support for writing your application as well as administrative and application review support.

Webinar: The NFR/RCN announces two new FRIPRO calls for Groundbreaking Research

As part of strengthening its focus on groundbreaking research, the research council has announced the addition of two new calls to the FRIPRO family:

- Top Researchers
- Radical Research Ideas for Early Career Scientists.

The webinar will explain the details of the two calls: who can apply, what you can apply for, and with what limitations.

They will also explain how these new calls fit in with FRIPRO's existing calls for groundbreaking research. Both calls will open later this month and the first projects funded under these two calls are expected to be announced in October or December.

Upcoming Deadlines: Human Frontier Science Program Postdoctoral Fellowships

The HFSP fellowship program supports proposals for frontier, potentially transformative research in the life sciences, especially high-risk projects. The projects should be interdisciplinary in nature and should challenge existing paradigms by using novel approaches and techniques. Scientifically, they should address an important problem or a barrier to progress in the field.

Deadline (Letter of Intent): 15 May 2025 **Deadline (Proposal):** 25 September 2025

Upcoming Deadline: MH's Internal Process for Applications for Research Equipment 2026

MH faculty can apply for up to 12 million NOK, split between four equipment projects. The maximum allocation for a single project is approximately NOK 6 million.

This limit does not apply to projects that are submitted by several faculties together (see section 5 of the call text). Departments are expected to contribute a **deductible of 10%**.

The internal process at MH for prioritising applications will be:

- 24 March: Deadline for applications to the faculty
 - A prioritisation overview is available in a separate form
 - Applications should be written in a separate application form either in Norwegian or English
 - Remember that applications led by other departments/faculties must also be submitted.
- 28 March: Processing of applications/prioritisation meeting
- **01 April:** Anchoring of prioritisation in the department head meeting, possibly refinement of the applications
- 22 April: Briefing in the dean's meeting
- 25 April: Submission of applications and priority list

The application form, guidelines, announcement text with requirements, etc. have been distributed to the departments on 11.02.

Upcoming Deadlines: NordForsk Nordic-Baltic initiative on responsible use of Artificial Intelligence

NordForsk has announced funding for a minimum of 12 Nordic and Nordic-Baltic research projects, up to 16.3 million NOK:

Nordic-Baltic initiative on responsible use of Artificial Intelligence - Making the most of the potentials and mitigating the risks and harmful consequences of the use of Artificial Intelligence in the Nordic-Baltic region.

The aim of this call is to fund excellent research activities that address shared Nordic and Nordic-Baltic societal challenges in the context of extensive use and implementation of AI in the region.

"Applications should respond to societal challenges that the Nordic and Nordic-Baltic region is facing. These challenges include, but are not limited to, ageing populations, ongoing structural developments in the labour market, societal and political polarisation, health systems, education, competence development and lifelong learning and the green transition of the economy."

It is desired that projects contribute to cross-border mobilisation of capacity and competence building among Nordic and Nordic-Baltic research communities and strengthen networks and collaborations. The research consortium must include research performing organisations in at least four Nordic or Baltic countries, of which at least three must be Nordic.
