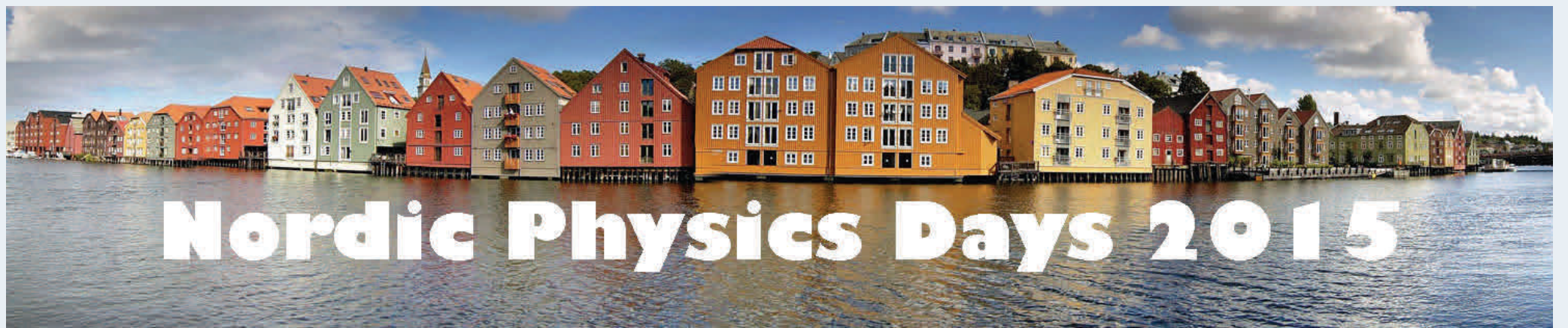




Welcome to Trondheim, Norway June 9-12, 2015
