

# Program overview

SCANDEM 2016 is hosted by NTNU, the Norwegian University of Science and Technology in Trondheim, Norway. Several departments from the life and physical sciences are involved in the organization, and our goal is to make an attractive conference for people from both fields, focusing on both life and materials science. The program is shown below – we will have three plenary speakers and 5 parallel sessions (10 all together) in life and materials science, also with invited speakers. The emphasis will be on microscopy, not only electron microscopy, but also light and other forms of microscopy. Invited plenary speakers are **Peter Peters (Maastricht)**, **Paul Midgley (Cambridge)** and **Sara Bals (Antwerp)**. In addition we are now inviting speakers for the parallel sessions, so far we have confirmed participation from **Quentin Ramasse (Daresbury)**, **Andreas Brecht (Oslo)** and **Lucy Collinson (London)**. The five sessions in life science are: Molecular scales, Bio-nano, Neuroscience, Correlative microscopy and Cellular imaging. The five sessions in Materials science are Nanomaterials, Geology, Instrumentation, Functional materials and Structural materials.







A map of Trondheim, showing the location of the two hotels and the conference venue is shown in the first map, the second shows Gløshaugen campus.




Trondheim centre




Gløshaugen Campus

Entrance to Natural Science building




#### **Exhibition SCANDEM 2016**

The exhibition will be in the area outside the two lecture halls where the plenary (R7) and parallel (R7 and R5) sessions are held. The natural science building is a modern building from year 2000 with easy access and a good infrastructure for hosting a technically demanding commercial exhibition. All exhibitor stands will be grouped in the same area. A map of the area with indicated positions for stands is shown below.


