

## Innovative and Sustainable Energy Engineering (ISEE)

### Doing Master thesis in Aalto University:

Usually in Aalto University, we invite all the students from ISEE international program who study Bioenergy track (second year) and the students who study Energy System track (first year) to a meeting (typically held in the beginning of September) to discuss all matters related to their studies and also give them information about the research topics in our units and how to search for thesis topics within the department of Mechanical Engineering. In addition, we encourage the students to contact professors who are responsible for the fields mentioned in our track and also encourage them to start contact companies in Finland who are involved in Energy sector in order to get a topic for the master thesis. In general, the professor who introduce the thesis topic, will be the supervisor of the student and in case the student found a thesis topic from a company then he/or she could choose the professor who works in the same field or the subject of the topic.

It will be useful and efficient if the student start straight away to be active in searching for a master thesis topic during autumn semester because it will be easier to start doing the thesis work immediately in the beginning of spring semester.
