## What is NRSN?

- A national **collaboration** among universities in Norway to coordinate and improve the PhD education in Neuroscience
- A **supplement** to the universities' own PhD programs
- Coordinated by the Kavli Institute for Systems Neuroscience, NTNU

## We aim to provide:

A training opportunity for the next generation of Norwegian-trained neuroscientists by combining and extending the specific expertise of the participating institutions.

## Registration fee:

- To support the activities of NRSN, we have implemented a pay-per-student model
- Several institutes have agreed to pay half of the fee, the rest needs to be covered by the supervisor
- Registration fee is 11,000 NOK per year
- First-year students need to commit for 3 years

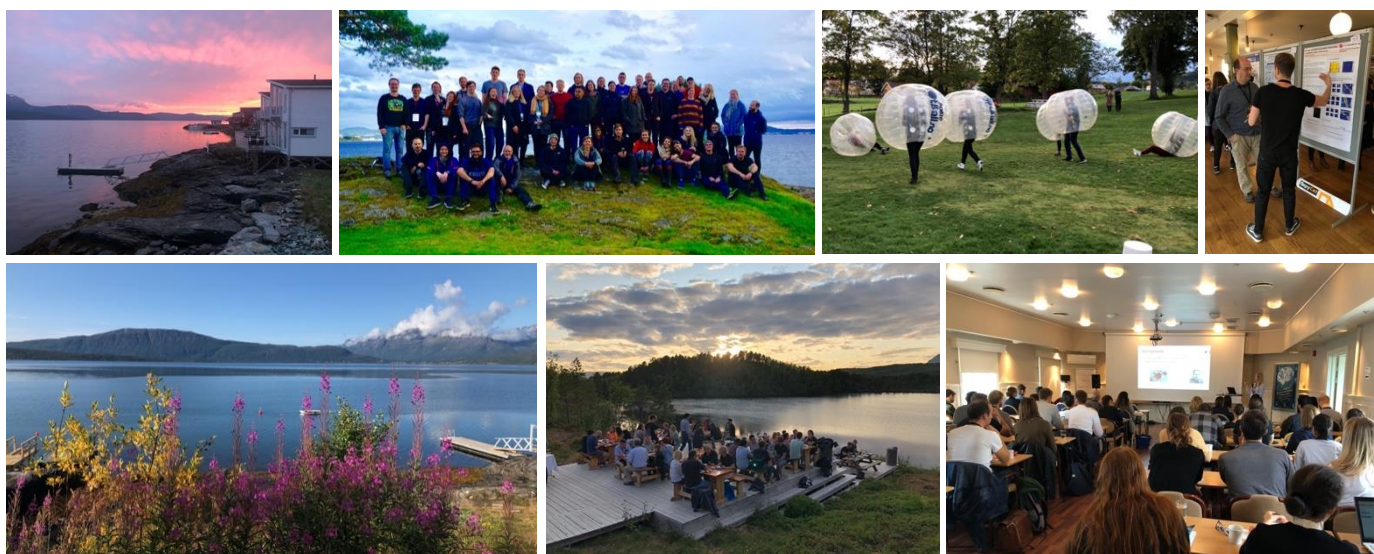
## Why sign up for NRSN now?
