Guidelines and criteria for presentation

Guiding questions as preparation for your project presentation

Clearly state the problem that you aim to solve in your project.

- What is the problem?
- Who is it a problem for?
- How big is the problem?

What is your idea/concept and how can it solve the problem?

- What is the current solution to this problem?
- What aspect(s) of the problem do you solve and how?
- What is the benefit of your solution and for whom?

What is needed to make your idea successful (feasibility)?

- Who is the user of your solution?
- Is there a target customer (the one who pays) for your solution?
- What is the value of your solution to the user and the target customer?

How does your idea creates value for society?

- What could be the benefit to society of your solution? Think of social, economic and environmental impacts.

What competences are needed to develop the solution?

- How have the interdisciplinary competences in the team contributed to the solution?
- How did the interdisciplinary collaboration process contribute to the solution?

What is the quality of the presentation?

- Does the presentation and discussion provide clear insight into the problem, the group's solution, feasibility of the project, benefit to society, and interdisciplinary collaboration in the project?

Your presentation

- 5-minute presentation (with or without slides).
- Present in English or Norwegian.

Recommended structure:

- ✓ Introduction & summary
- ✓ Problem & current solutions
- ✓ Your solution & target audience
- ✓ Value to society & future development
