Any M.Sc. or Ph.D. student who is the sole or first author of an accepted paper with her/his advisors and co-advisors can apply for the student paper award. The student has to be registered, have proof of her/his status, attend the conference and present the paper. The evaluation will be based on the reviewer's reports and the ECCTD 2015 Organizing Committee will make the decision jointly.
