

Reaching Athens center from the Athens International Airport

Syntagma square is in the center of Athens, bordered on the east side by the Hellenic Parliament Building. Syntagma square is the hub of public transportation in the city: buses, trolleys, the tram, and the metro all stop here.

BY METRO (OPTION 1)

Syntagma is accessible from the Airport with Metro Line 3: "Airport - Aghia Marina".

BY BUS (OPTION 2)

All buses depart from the Arrivals Level, between Exits 4 and 5. Bus X95 "Syntagma - Airport" brings you to the city center. The ticket costs €5. Details on the X95 route, departures' timetable from/ to the airport, and other useful information can be found at:

BY TAXI (OPTION 3)

The taxi queue starts from Exit 4 of the Arrivals Level in AIA and extend up to Exit 1. The journey cost from the airport to Syntagma square is approximately 40 - 45 euros.
