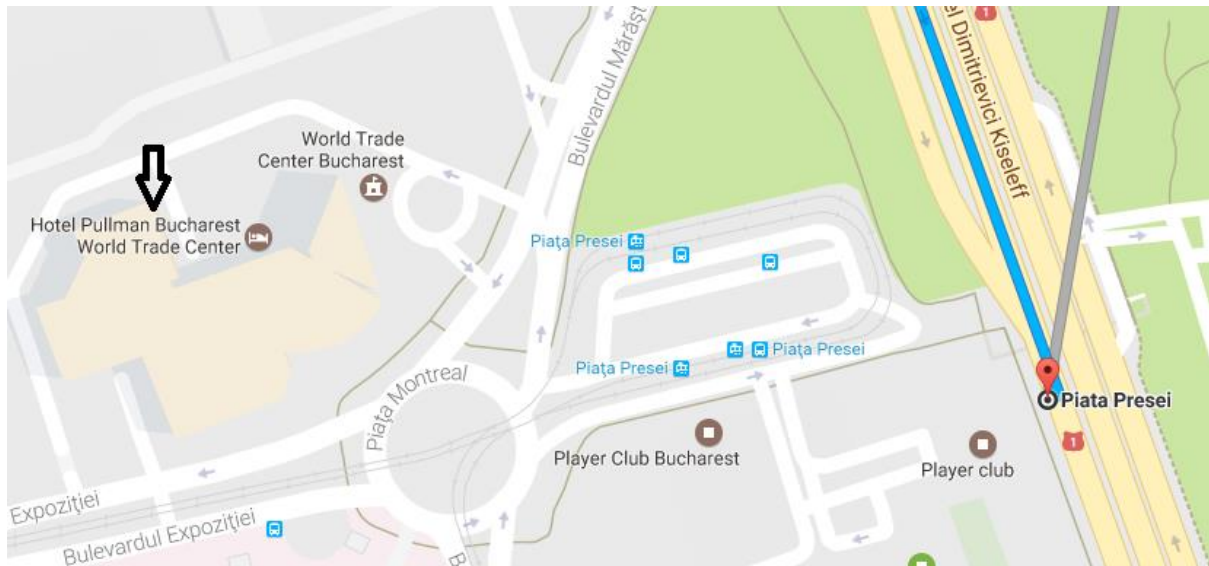

QUICK ORIENTATION

GETTING FROM THE AIRPORT TO PULLMAN HOTEL

From the airport, take bus 783 (express line), which connects Henri Coandă airport to the city center. Travel from the airport to Piața Presei station (on Bd. Pavel Dimitrieviici Kiseleff). Then walk to Pullman Hotel (about 6 minutes).

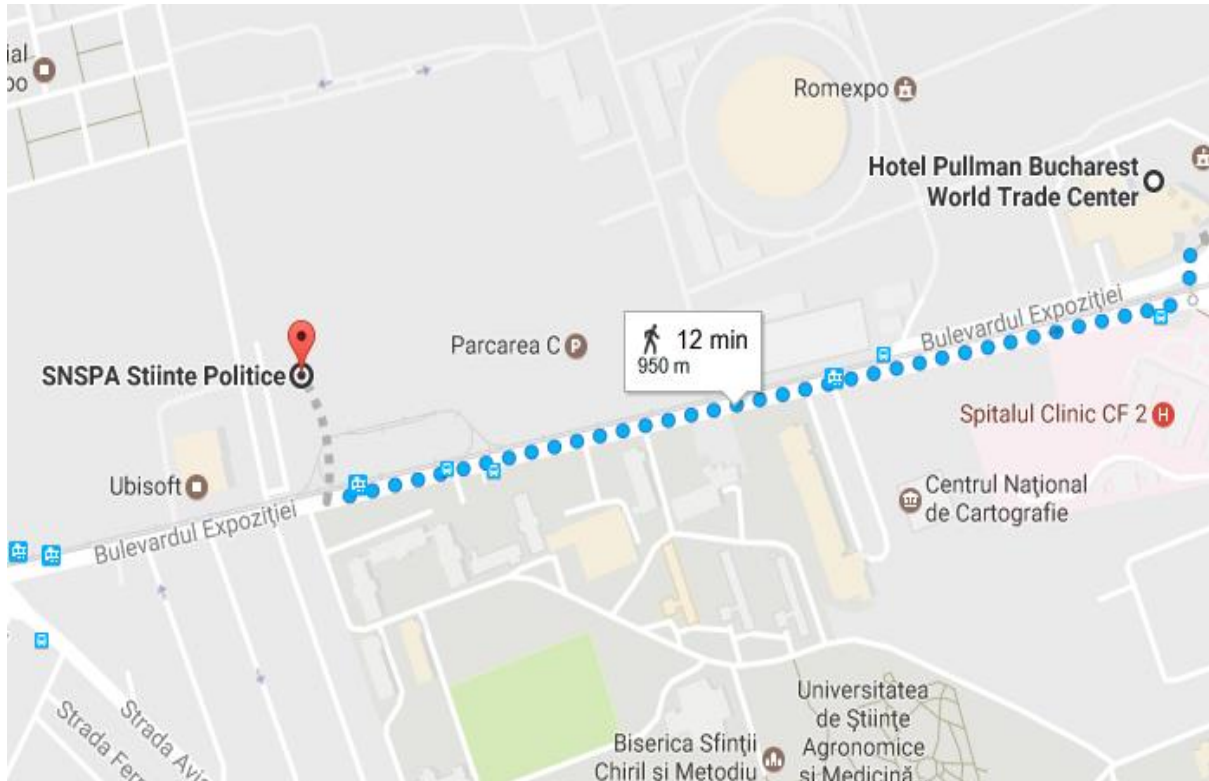


If you take a taxi, it should cost you around 10 Euros (less if the traffic is light). Before you exit the airport, order a taxi using the yellow terminal on the right and left sides. Make sure you choose the lowest price (you can choose the taxi company by price or name). You should take the taxi that costs 1.39 lei/km (first line on the screen). If you have difficulties in using the machines, ask for assistance from the airport staff.

GETTING FROM PULLMAN HOTEL TO THE VENUE

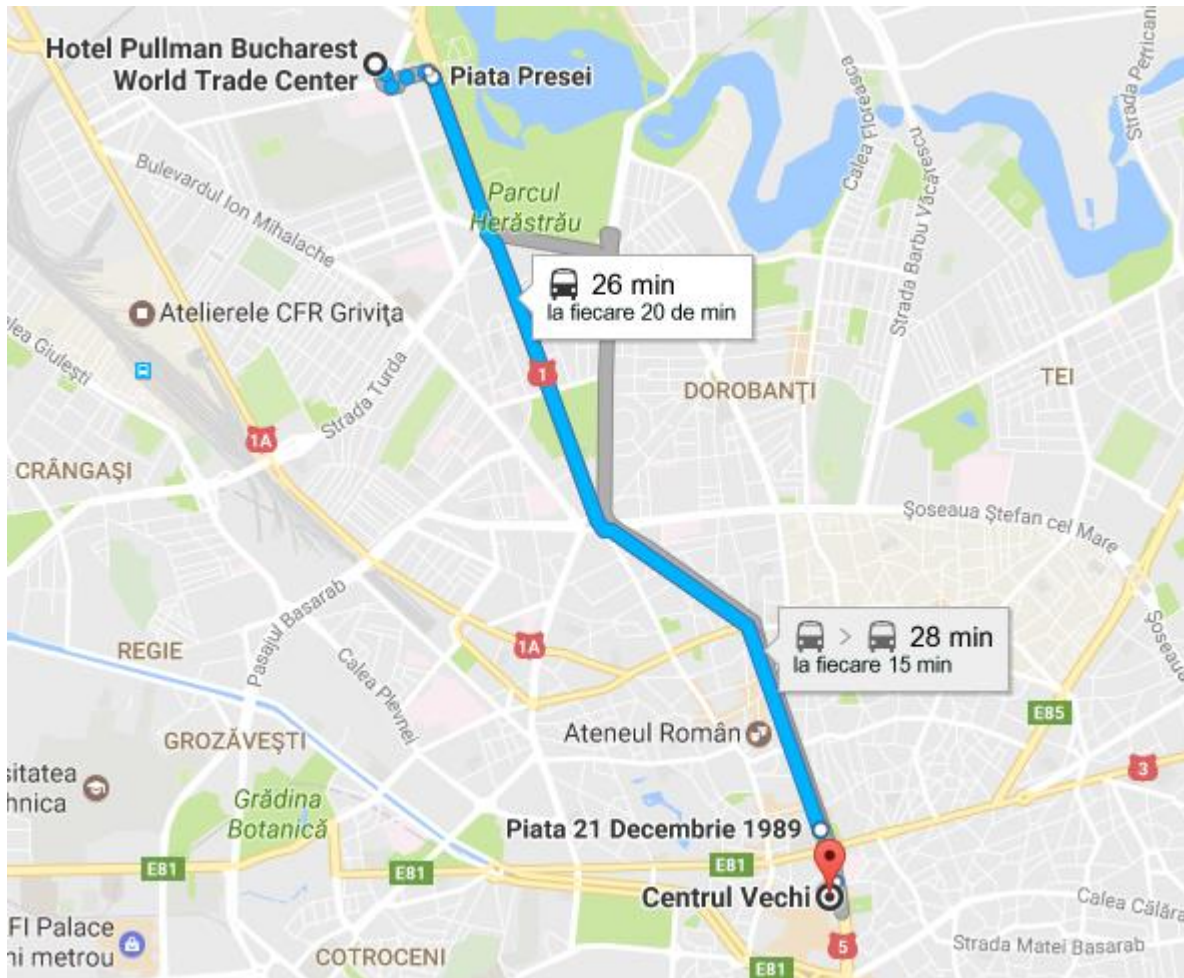
National University of Political and Administrative Studies, Bd. Expoziției, 30A, Bucharest, Romania.

GETTING FROM PULLMAN HOTEL TO BUCHAREST CITY CENTER

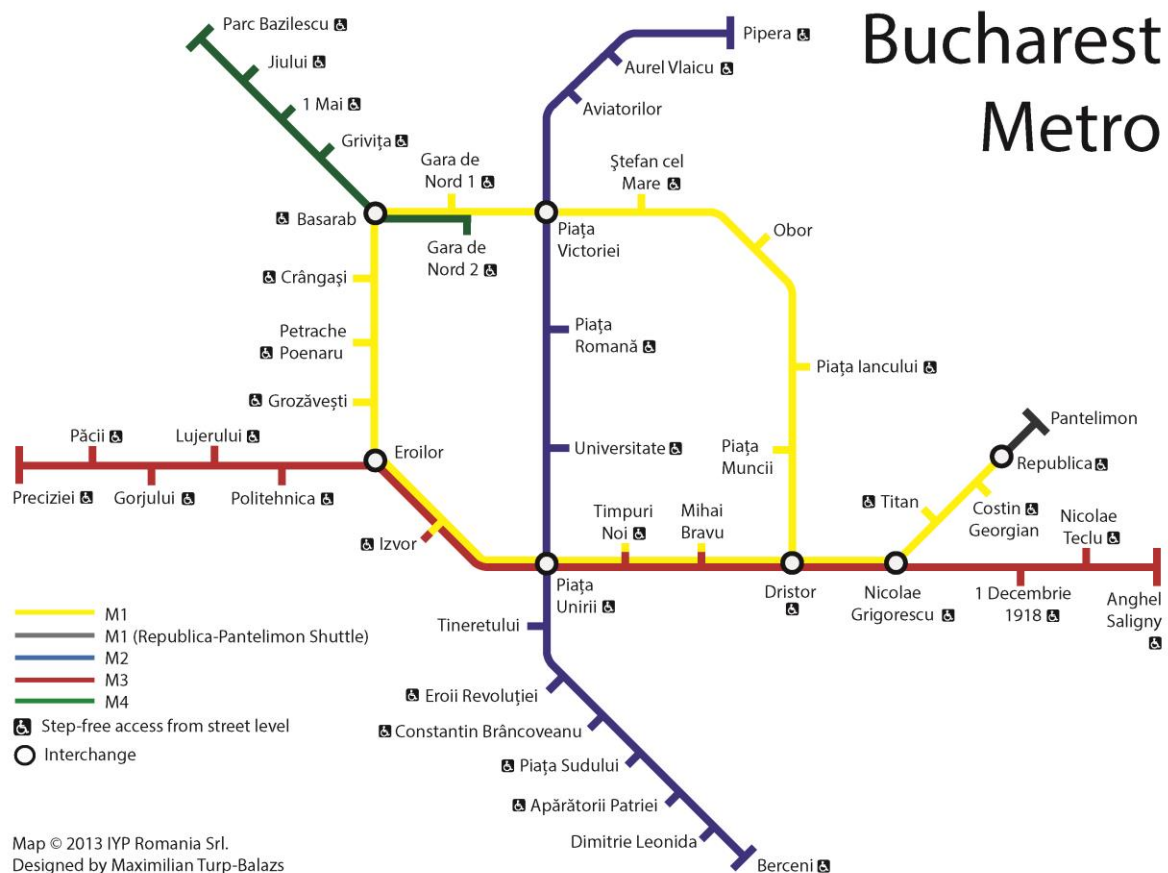
From Pullmann Hotel walk to Piața Presei station. Then take bus 783 (express line) to Piața 21 decembrie 1989 (4 stops). Then walk for about 500 meters to Piața Unirii.



BUS TICKETS

You can buy bus tickets for all the urban lines (including express lines – e.g., 783) from each bus station. For the bus 783, you have to buy a Multiple card (1.6 lei – the cost of the card – plus either only 2 tickets for the price of 7 lei, or 10 tickets for the price of 27 lei).
